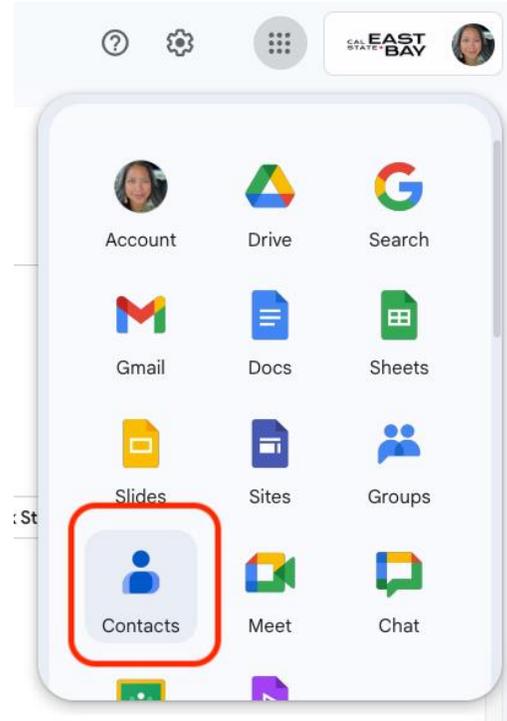


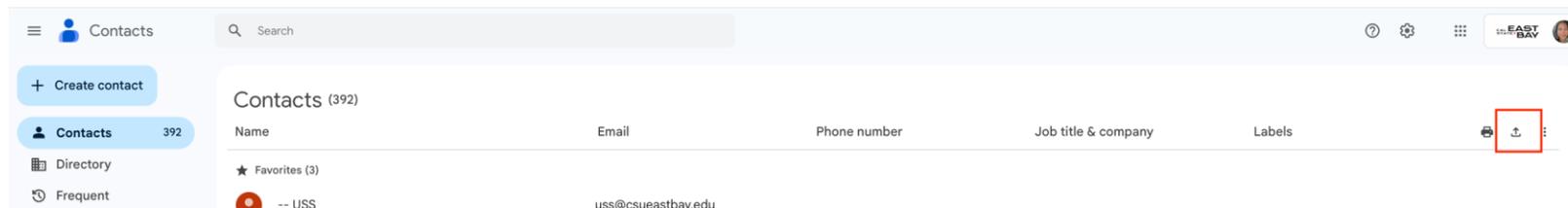
Migrating Contacts

Exporting Google Contacts to Outlook Contacts

1. Go to Google Contacts.

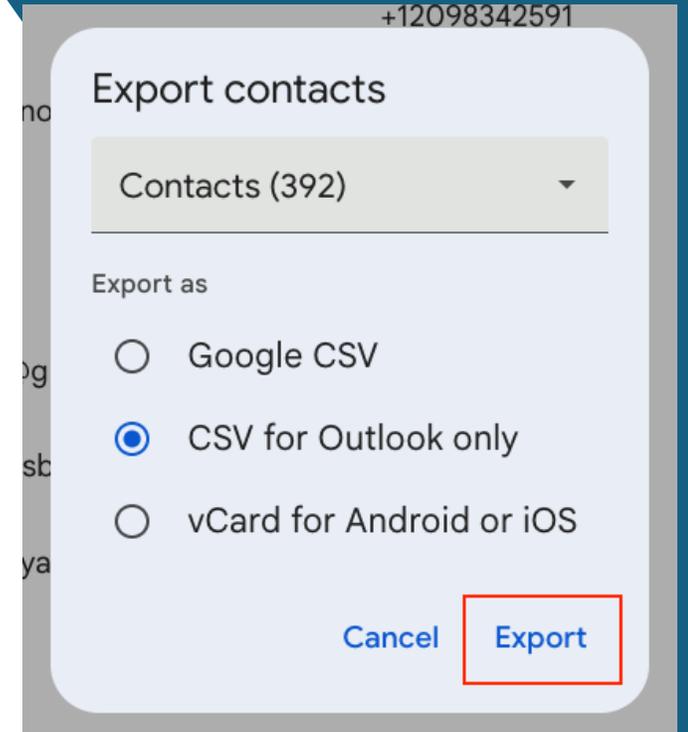


2. Click the "Export" icon on the top menu bar, far right.



Exporting Google Contacts to Outlook Contacts

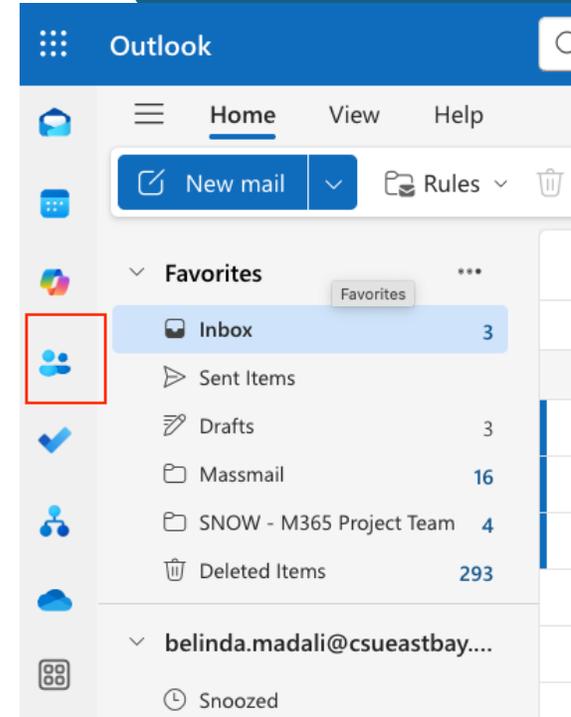
3. Choose “CSV for Outlook only” and click Export.



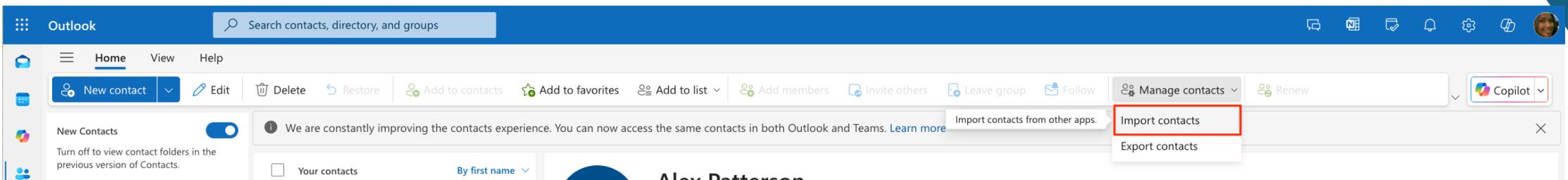
3. The file will download to your default download folder. Typically this is your “Downloads” folder. File name is: **contacts.csv**

Importing Contacts Into Outlook

1. In your Outlook Mail click the People icon.

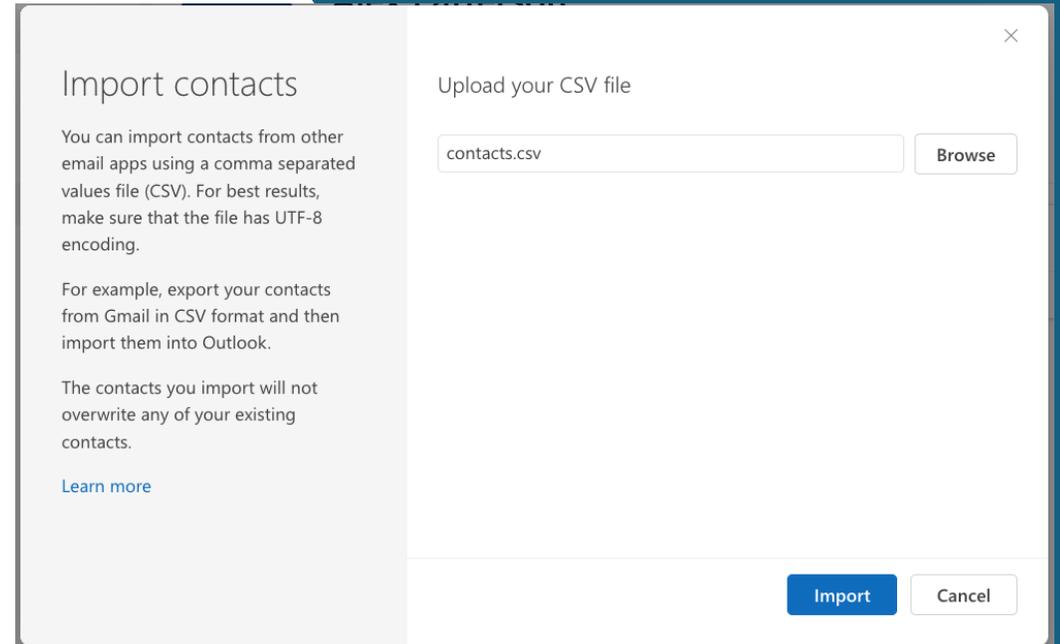


2. Under the Manage Contacts tab, choose "Import Contact"

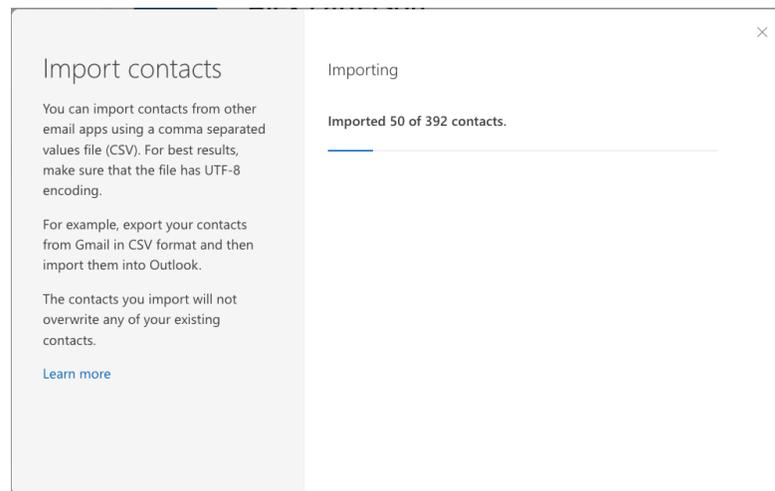


Importing Contacts Into Outlook

3. Click the “Browse” button and find the contacts.csv file that was downloaded, then click Import.



4. Import will begin.



Importing Contacts Into Outlook

5. You will receive the confirmation dialog box stating how many contacts were imported.

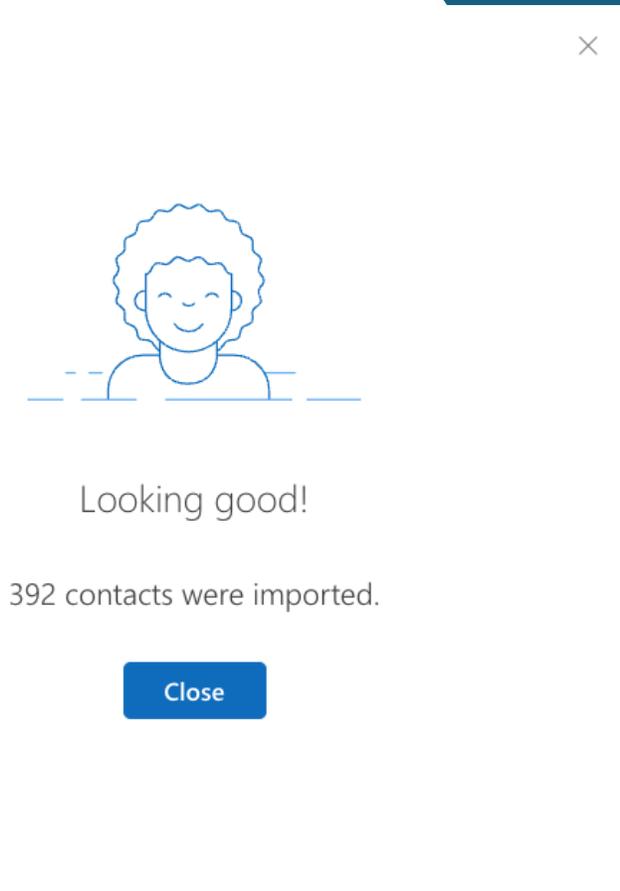
Import contacts

You can import contacts from other email apps using a comma separated values file (CSV). For best results, make sure that the file has UTF-8 encoding.

For example, export your contacts from Gmail in CSV format and then import them into Outlook.

The contacts you import will not overwrite any of your existing contacts.
