See below cost **ESTIMATES** unique to the Pre-Licensure Nursing Program. These requirements are necessary to prepare for interventions class, SIM lab and clinical rotations – they meet standards set by our community hospital partners with patient safety emphasized. Not all fees are required up front. Several healthcare-related scholarships are available on the Cal State East Bay [Community Scholarships](#) or [Pioneer Scholarships](#) page, which may be able to help pay for these items.

East Bay Student Nurses Association (EBSNA) Fee	\$100
National Student Nurses Association (NSNA) Fee	\$80
Textbooks	\$900 - \$1500
Medical Supplies and Scrubs (entire three years) – items such as stethoscope, clipboard, watch, pens, comfortable shoes, and other individual supplies to use at clinical site	\$300
Background Check, Drug Test, Online Immunization Tracking	\$150
Health Document Requirements – Labs and Tests	\$300 – varies with insurance
N95 Mask Fitting	\$50 - 100
Online HealthStream Modules - Hospital Safety Training	\$20
First Aid and CPR Certification Class - CPR must be <i>American Heart Association</i> BLS for Healthcare Providers	\$95
CPR Certification Renewal (after second year)	\$80
Uniform Nametags	\$15 / tag
Cal State East Bay Nursing Patches	\$6 / patch
