#### How Do I Apply to Cal State East Bay's Post-Licensure Collaborative program?

The Post-Licensure Collaborative Advanced Placement Option is a 12 month intensive or 2 year part-time program. All courses are online except for the Community Health practicum. The program begins in the fall term after completion of the ADN program and passing the RN licensing exam (NCLEX). Incoming ADN students will be awarded 15 upper division college credit units for passing the NCLEX-RN exam.

Eligibility: 1) Enrollment in an ADN program & 2) Meet all Cal State East Bay admission requirements
