Professor Richard (Dick) Tullis passed away on February 25, 2018. Dick was an Emeritus Professor of Biological Sciences and joined the faculty at CSUH in 1972 after earning his doctorate at the University of Hawaii. Over his many years at Cal-State Dick, a physiologist, was a committed educator of many undergraduate and graduate students. For over ten years he was a strong and outspoken department chair and highly praised for shepherding the Department through the tribulations of renovation in the College of Science. He was an active member of the CSUH Foundation and a strong advocate for research activities. He was also a devoted supporter of the programs at the Moss Landing Marine Laboratories.
