- Open issues
 - Motorized Scooter Policy (Brenda)
 - We think we should have a motorized scooter policy.
 - Noticed there are many students living off campus at City View using motorized scooters since University Village Shuttle was cancelled.
 - We collected data from other CSU's on their policies, will share (Eduina)
 - Majority of CSU's do not allow motorized scooters on campus (Eduina)
 - Did we ever have a policy? (Paul) No, recently there have been a few found parked within a building. They can stall out when they leave the Geofence area (Brenda)
 - Now more privately owned scooters? (Paul) Yes (Brenda)
 - What about motorized skateboards? (Paul) Yes that would also be included in the policy (Brenda)
 - Working a policy with UPD & Risk Management, will be shared with ATC
 - Adding Micromobility page to Website (Brenda)
 - We want to add a page to our website about Micromobility to encourage micromobility use on campus safely and correctly. This is in relation to us getting calls about what is allowed on campus.
 - This would include policies/rules and recommendations.
 - Does the current TDM include Micromobility? (Paul) It is not in the [current TDM](#) but should be added to the upcoming assessment in 2025. (Brenda)
 - Bike Share Update (Brenda)
 - Previous program primarily used by University Village students; most bikes left downhill. Low usage for Pioneer Heights students, they use for short distance.
 - Currently reduced number of students at on campus housing.
 - Add a question to the upcoming transportation survey about bringing back bike share program.
 - Also we'd like to work with the City of Hayward on a joint program- help students discover Downtown Hayward on bikes. If this doesn't work out we can have our own program and geofence the campus.

- Ask CoH what improvements they are available for bike safety- bike & pedestrian walkways. (Paul)
 - We can also bring this up as a recommendation suggestion to the president to improve bike infrastructure and pedestrian safety on campus
 - Good idea to encourage CoH to do improve bike infrastructure, long project, maybe progress in 10 years? LOL (Tony)
 - Tony rides his bike to campus daily! Noticed new bike safety on campus drive. Hard to get up the hill
 - We should look at e-bikes will help with going uphill, they are the future (Paul)
 - STARS Report Update (Paul)
 - Starting next update in Spring 2023- can take 6-12 month process
 - 4 components: Fleet, Student mode of transportation, Employee mode of transportation and support policies around promoting alternative transportation.
 - 4 points max in each (currently 1.9) Report is currently on Sustainability website under [Commitment](#)
 - Should be a permanent part of the agenda- collecting information (we get some information from transportation survey)
 - Our greenhouse gas emissions is 50% transportation- this committee is very important to pushing different means to reduce emissions of SOV.

 - Before our next meeting can we discuss this funding opportunity related to making our bus fleet cleaner (Tony)

 - [Over \\$100 million in funding is available to assist grantees in reducing their emissions through vehicle and equipment replacement.](#)
