

Application for Graduation For Students Who do not have a Current, Open Matriculation

All students must have satisfied the University Writing Skills Requirement (UWSR) to be eligible to apply for graduation. Undergraduate students must also have completed at least 90 semester units to file for graduation.

Instructions:

- 1. Submit completed form with payment made payable to "CSU East Bay" in one of the following ways. Payment must be included when submitting this graduation application.
 - a. In Person: Submit to the Cashier's Office in the Student Administration Building at the Hayward Campus or to the Academic Services Lobby at the Concord Campus.
 - b. Mail To: Cashier's Office, Cal State East Bay, 25800 Carlos Bee Blvd, Hayward, CA 94542
- 2. Request and submit official transcripts from your transfer institution (if applicable) to be sent to Cal State East Bay. Contact your major and minor departments to determine if further documentation and/or a new major check and/or minor check is required for your major or minor.
