

Petition to Exceed 18 Semester Units of Withdrawal

Undergraduate students may withdraw from no more than 18 semester units of coursework, including any courses taken in CSUEB Open University, in their undergraduate careers. When serious illness or accidents are documented and used as a basis for approval of withdrawal from all classes in the term, the units will not count against the 18 semester unit maximum allowed. Students who will exceed the 18 maximum units allowed may petition for a waiver of the requirement to allow for additional withdrawals.
