Latin Honors:

To qualify for latin honors undergraduate* students need to have completed at least 40 units in residence; have a minimum CSUEB GPA of 3.65; and have a minimum CUM GPA of 3.65. If all three of these criteria are met, students will earn latin honors based on their CUM GPA at the time their degree is being awarded according to the following breakdown:

Summa Cum Laude: 3.85-4.00Magna Cum Laude: 3.75-3.84

• Cum Laude: 3.65-3.74
