## When to File for Graduation

Currently accepting applications for Summer or Fall 2024

- > Priority deadline: March 1
- Late deadline: April 2



## Departments Involved in Graduation

- ➤ Academic Advisors (Major Dept/College Advising Center)
  - > Advise on requirements for Major and General Education
  - > Send major check to Graduation Evaluations
- Graduation Evaluation (Office of the Registrar)
  - After receiving major check the graduation evaluator will do a review of your academic record and send you an email that summarizes the requirements necessary for graduation.

## **Graduation Status**

Applied: Graduation application has been received

Major Check Received: Major check has been received by the Office of the Registrar.

**Degree Requirements have been Reviewed**: Degree requirements have been preliminarily reviewed and your graduation evaluator has sent a summary of your graduation evaluation to your Horizon email.

**Awarded**: Degree is awarded. Posted on the transcript immediately. Notification will be sent to your Horizon email once awarded.



## **Important Reminders**

- > Continue to meet with your academic advisor.
- > Check to ensure that all majors/minors/concentrations are officially recorded on your record.
- > Complete all degree requirements by the last day of finals.



## Degree Name

- > Students can select a degree name (first and middle) that will be used in the commencement program and on the diploma.
- This can be updated in MyCSUEB by selecting the *Profile* tile, then selecting 'Pref Name', then selecting 'degree name'.



- > Deadline to update degree name
  - For Commencement program: March 1, 2024.
  - For Spring 2024 diploma: April 30, 2024



# **Postponing Graduation Term**

- If you are not going to complete all graduation requirements in the term in which you filed, complete a "Request to Postpone or Cancel Graduation" form.
- You can update your graduation one semester; undergraduate students will be charged a \$25 postponement fee.



### **Graduate Registration**

- Graduates will receive a message via their horizon student email (horizon.csueastbay.edu) in mid-March to register.
- RSVP that you are attending your ceremony.

#### **Ceremony Graduate Name Reader**

- Through the registration process, graduates will be asked to provide a recording of their name.
- This step is crucial to ensure the accurate pronunciation of names during the ceremony.

#### **Tickets**

- Tickets will be available to claim on the registration site in early April for their guests.
- The number of tickets vary depending on ceremony size.
- All children 4 and older will need a ticket.

- At check-in during Commencement, you will be given a name reader card:
  - DO NOT LOSE YOUR CARD!
  - In the event of losing your card, a Marshall will provide assistance and guide you to the rear of the line.

#### **Parking**

- Graduates can obtain parking permits at Gradfest or after with Parking & Transportation Services Department beginning March 25, 2024.
- Each commencement ceremony will have their own unique special commencement parking permit that will only be valid on its designated date.
- Each graduate will receive three (3) parking permits, we strongly encourage carpooling.
- Parking passes must be displayed on the dashboard.
- Alternatively, additional shuttles are available only at the Downtown Hayward Bart.
