Strategic Goals

Goal 1: Academic Excellence and Innovation Objectives:

- ➤ Establish a path for undergraduate students in the major to obtain SLP-A certification in the undergraduate program.
- > Complete curricular review of current undergraduate and graduate coursework to reduce redundancies, expand breadth and identify logical sequence of courses.
- ➤ Explore development of undergraduate certificate(s) to increase depth of instruction in focus areas (for e.g., multilingualism/diversity issues).
- ➤ Review and refine current graduate capstone experience with a focus on authentic assessment of knowledge and skills across ASHA's Big 9 areas of practice
- ➤ Increase student recruitment and retention through student advising and mentoring programs.

Goal 2: Financial Sustainability Objectives:

➤ Launch online MS Program through Continuing Education with clear MOU for revenue sharing.

- ➤ Increase external funding for faculty scholarship and student research through grants and clinical contracts
- ➤ Collaborate with University Advancement to implement strategies for increasing donations to support students, programs, and facilities (e.g., outdoor clinic space).
- > Expand continuing education offerings to generate revenue for departmental activities.
- Develop a meaningful alumni engagement plan.

Goal 3: Growth and Expansion Objectives:

- > Increase undergraduate enrollment through university wide outreach
- ➤ Increase visibility of SLHS majors by increasing awareness of currently available SLHS GE courses for outside majors.
- ➤ Increase the number of tenured/tenure track faculty to meet student needs.
- > Grow the number of qualified bilingual clinical supervisors to support clinical instruction
- > Explore school district partnerships to fund graduate education for students.

Goal 4: Clinical Excellence and Impact Objectives:

- > Expand clinical programs through development of speciality clinics
- ➤ Integrate increased knowledge and practice in clinical writing and evidence based practice across courses (such as labs).
- ➤ Grow opportunities for specialized clinical training through various collaborations (e.g., IPP simulation clinics, speciality community based clinics, grant funded interprofessional training programs etc)
