Let's talk about our favorite teams and players! Keep up to date with March Madness and the Winter Olympics!

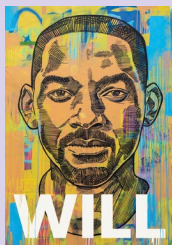
Virtual Tours: National Parks *New*

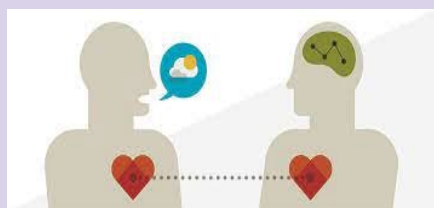
Book Club:
