- SPED 500, Introduction to Educating all Learners in Diverse Classrooms

Required Course Areas to meet ASHA requirements (outside the department. May be taken in a CR/NC grading pattern. Course equivalencies available at TES)

Biological Science Area (3): BIOL 270 (4) **Human Physiology & Anatomy I** or another Biology course

Physical Science Area (3): Physics or Chemistry course

Social Science Area (3): **PSYC 100 (3) General Psychology**, OR **HDEV 380 (3) Lifespan Human Development**, or another course

Statistics Area (3): **STAT 100 (3) Elements of Statistics and Probability** or another statistics course

The Area courses should meet the criteria set by ASHA.

Additional recommended courses for

Biology: BIOL 100, BIOL 101, BIOL 140A, BIOL 140B, BIOL 230, BIOL 270, and BIOL 271.

Physical Science: PHYS 104, PHYS 109, PHYS 115, CHEM 100, and CHEM 161.

Social Science: PSYC 100, HDEV 380, HDEV 381, HDEV 311, and HDEV 322.
