<p><b>Degree Requirements</b></p> <p>Students may need up to <b>13 additional semester units</b> to meet degree unit requirements*. Recommended: SLHS 306 "Multilingualism in the U.S." (fulfills D4+Diversity overlay), biological/health sciences, communication, ethnic studies, early childhood education, English, human development, psychology, language studies, statistics. Students who are also pursuing a minor are expected to meet this additional unit requirement through their minor coursework.</p> <p>*Students should meet with a CLASS Student Services Advisor to confirm how many actual units are needed based on overall academic history, and to verify any pending unit/GE requirements: <a href="https://www.csueastbay.edu/class-ssc/index.html">https://www.csueastbay.edu/class-ssc/index.html</a></p>		
<p><b>Notes</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. HDEV 380 fulfills the G.E. UD (Upper Division) Area D requirement.</li><li>2. SLHS 204 fulfills the lower-division G.E. Area D1-2 requirement.</li><li>3. SLHS 305 must be taken twice.</li><li>4. PHYS 304 fulfills the G.E. UD (Upper Division) Area B requirement and is a prerequisite for SLHS 303. If a lower-division physics course dedicated to acoustics or the physics of sound has been taken, it can be petitioned as a major substitution, but not as a G.E. substitution.</li><li>5. SLHS 497 must be taken once, in any term a student wants to, though it can be taken up to two times if desired. Topics are expected to rotate between supervised volunteer experiences, lab volunteer experiences, and special topics.</li></ol>
