

Pre-Columbian Art Exhibit Ends With Reception Today

The Cal State Hayward University Union has an upstairs.

This may be a revelation to some, thinking that perhaps those steps next to the ATM are like an M.C. Escher, or perhaps a Dali, painting, and lead nowhere in particular.

But those steps lead to the Associated Students offices, a quiet study area and an outside patio that overlooks the hustle

and bustle of weekday activities. Upstairs in the Union, Chimal Arce, Associated Students marketing and programs coordinator puts together photography exhibits.

Recently he has put together an apt homage for Sept. 11.

But in celebration of Columbus Day (celebrated Oct. 8), Arce has created a photo exhibit on Meso-America. The exhibit, called "Before Christopher Columbus," will continue its short run through Friday, Oct. 12.

Today there will be a 7 p.m.

reception with a presentation by Arce, and pre-Columbian music performed by artist Martin Espino.

Espino, of Mexican/Indigenous ancestry (Yaqui and Odami), has researched his art thoroughly, and performs on instruments he made himself from natural resources.

"In this way I preserve ancient cultural traditions," said Espino.

He has earned numerous awards and received his bachelor of music degree from the Immaculate Heart College in clas-

sical guitar and in performance/research of instruments from medieval and Renaissance periods.

Espino will bring over 150 pre-Hispanic instruments, including ocarinas, panpipes, gourds and various percussion instruments. The only stringed instrument will be the Hunter's Bow, since other strings like violins and guitars came from European contact.

He will perform traditional music, original compositions, and ambient music based on the musical structures of the pre-Columbian period.
