The dance, combined with a strange tug-of-war act, had the audience laughing at their clownish wit.

Jose Navarette and Debby Kajiyama, guest artists, burned up the dance floor with their tango variations. They seemed to fuse into one person, as their fancy moves and sexy chemistry gave an aura of daring to the show. Their performance, titled "Asobitango," was both risqué and poetic, with the two partners dressed in matching tuxedoe.

Interspersed between the sexy contortions and tragic ballet, were a few numbers that were all about fun. "Just a Li'l Something" and "On Fire" were both lively hip-hop tunes that featured young ladies joyfully shaking their booties in an imaginary disco. The carefree departure was a good move, as the funky action was greeted with hoots and
