Kimiko Guthrie and Eric Kupers' Dandelion Dancetheatre is premiering a piece in San Francisco this Friday. The show will run for three weeks. Kumpers did the choreography and four of the performers are CSUH alumni.

It is called "Night Marsh" and is the culmination of Dandelion Dancetheater's Undressed Project, in which 15 dancers of diverse size, shape, race and age all dance together completely naked to challenge society's prejudices around body image.


