Stay Safe with the CSUEB SAFE App!

The CSUEB SAFE App provides customized safety, emergency, and support resources for our campus community. Key features include:

- Police/Fire/EMS:** Contact relevant services for all emergency and non-emergency safety concerns at CSUEB.
- Mobile Bluelight:** Share your location with UPD in real-time during a crisis.
- Friend Walk:** Let a friend track your live location for added safety.
- Campus Maps:** Access maps for Hayward and Concord campuses.
- Emergency Guides:** Prepare for and recover from emergencies.
- Report a Tip:** Share safety concerns or suspicious activity.
- Parking Info:** View parking and transportation options.
- Support Services:** Access crisis hotlines, medical help, counseling, and more.
