









USE OF FORCE

In 2020, CSUEBPD reviewed its Use of Force policy and included Assembly Bill 392 declaring that every person has a right to be free from excessive use of force by officers acting under color of law. During the period from January 2016 to December 2020, there have been zero Use of Force incidents involving our officers.

TRAINING

In addition to the statistics provided, CSUEBPD officers receive extensive training in interacting with a diverse community like our campus. Starting with the Police Academy, all officers are required to complete Cultural Diversity Awareness training. UPD officers also receive continuous training on the following:

- Interpersonal Communication
- Mental Health Awareness
- Threat Assessment De-escalation
- Racial Profiling Awareness
- Crisis Intervention
- Domestic Violence Updates
- Sexual Assault and Survivor Training
- Trauma Informed Investigations
